Many of these fellows became Presbyterians eventually. Sloan did not continue very long to support the seminary. We had in the first year a wonderful unity as far as I could see. At the end of the first year, at the beginning of the second, Dr. R.D. Wilson died. They got out a little pamphlet that second year called Our Faculty. I came across a copy of it yesterday. I wanted to show it to you. But I did not see it this morning when I looked for it. But it has a statement about Dr. VanTil which I had never read until yesterday and it really shocked me what it said.
