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interesting incident of how the modernists fight for toleration. They want to be tolerated. There is room in the church for different views, etc. But once they get control thei seize it, really take it. That finishes up that then, doesn't it.

Here's this little pamphlet called Our Faculty prepared by the Student's Committee on Pulbications, Westminster Student Assn'n 1931. It tells a little about each member of the faculty. There is my picture, and here where it tells about VanTil I never read this until recently. It says, Dr. VanTil's main thesis is that either the God of the Bible is God, or there is no God. Since pragmatism idealism, personalism, and all other such philoosphies of the day deny the God of the Bible, it follows, says Dr. VanTil, that the God they would substitute is not God at all. Christian theism is the only position that consistent *X* thinker can hold. All other philosophies rob the universe of God."

That's pretty much nonsense in my opinion. But that summarizes what most of the students over the years have become tremendously enamoured over, and it cuts the ground from real Christian apologetics it seems to me.
