We were up there in Oslo. Right near. I forget whether it was Oslo. Somewhere in Scandanavia and we went over to Moscow and saw it.

But McIntire spoke and referred to it that way! He critisized Clark and Millheim in the Beacon and attacked them so, and then after all that when Millheim left the ACCC to go with the school at Clark Summit, he got a phone call that McIntire would like to see him. He was not in the office. They told him he had gone over to NJ to see someone. He said, How can I get in touch with him? He got in touch with him there and said, Will you come over and see me? So he went over to see him, and said, You don't want to go to that little school to work for them with your gifts. He said, Come here and be my assistant!

Millheim said, I nearly fell over. The way he'd been attacking me. Now he was wanting me to come and be his assistant. He does not realize that people people don't take that kind of attack. He doesn't realize that. He never was that way as a young fellow I don't believe but he's too busy to think things through and he gets this complex that you must follow me in everything. It's sad. Because there are a lot of things he has put effort on that perhaps the effort would be better put on other things, but I'd like to see somebody put effort on them, on just about everything he's been putting iton!

But I feel he has a gift he could be using to accomplish far more for the Lord, and I think he's created an antagonism against himself that ¢vst cuts down on his usefulness, tremendously.

I was sorry when I had to leave him, etc. but I can see why people get this attitude toward him. I don't take that attitude toward him, but to look at his recent Beacons would seem that he does toward me. Yet when you thinkhe went after Millheim must stronger than he has against me, and thenhe turned and around and askedhim to work with him!

Maybe that's all we ought to do today.
