My son was invited to go to Ohio to be Ashbrooks assistant. It would have been a fine experience. Ashbrook spent a lot of time helping his assistants. It would have been a great experience for him. I told him, we might need him around here next summer. And I think it is better you get something in this area for the summer.

Then as we approached the meeting he wanted to try to bring a couple of fellows from Florida he thought would be with us who were on the Board, but McIntire had practically all of them ready to say 'Amen' to whatever he would say. Of course the Board showed their attitude. Complet attitude. Faculty members, a dime a dozen! What can you do with a situation like that?

Very unfortuate because McIntire's big fight was against modernism. We certainly agree with that 100%. But we think that our purpose here is to win people to Christ and teach them to grow in grace and we think it is a vital but secondary part of our activity to oppose evil. The main thing is reaching people for the Lord. That is our main objective. And we feel that learning to understand the Bible as it really is is so important that it deserves a very high priority in our emphasis.

Since we left **WE** they had had very few American students there. McIntire can bring from foreign lands people as long as he pays their way over and takes care of them. They are fine Christian fellows he brings but they don't understand English so I don't know how much good they get out of it. Very sad. Really too bad.

But it was the situation, and we had to face. it. If Ken Lee had never been there I don't think we'd ever had the trouble. We could have handled Randy Pond easy. Randy Pond with Ken Lee backing him made kind of a front man for him. Subsequently a few years later Ken Lee and McIntire broke. Now Ken is kindof out of everything. That's it.
