Allan A. MacRae (BA, MA, Occidental College; MA, Princeton University; ThB, Princeton Theological Seminary; PhD, University of Pennsylvania) studied under R. A. Torrey at BIOLA, Robert Dick Wilson and J. Gresham Machen at Princeton Seminary, William F. Albright at the American Schools of Oriental Research at Jerusalem, and E. A. Speiser at the University of Pennsylvania.

Dr. MacRae taught Old Testament at three seminaries - Westminster, Faith and Biblical - and was founding president of the last two of these. Emphasizing the importance of studying the Scriptures with the care that God's inerrant revelation deserves, he prepared many students for Christian service, including Joseph T. Bayly, Arthur F. Glasser, Vernon C. Grounds, R. Laird Harris, Norman Jerome, Kenneth S. Kantzer, R. Allen Killen, Gordon R. Lewis, Robert E. Longacre, W. Harold Mare, Jack Murray, John W. Sanderson, Francis A. Schaeffer, Samuel J. Schultz, Elmer B. Smick, and G. Douglas Young.

Dr. MacRae has written several books, *Nuzi Personal Names* (with Ignace J. Gelb and Pierre M. Purves), *The Gospel of Isaiah*, *The Prophecies of Daniel* and *Bible-Centered Christianity: Letters from Prof Allan A. MacRae, Ph.D.* He served as an editor of the *New Scofield Reference Bible* and as a translator of the *New International Version* of the Bible. He has written articles for numerous periodicals and reference works, including the *Zondervan Pictorial Encyclopedia of the Bible* and *The New Bible Commentary*.
