them from getting back to their homes in Palestine, one cries in the whitxx wilderness, "Prepare # ye the way of the Lord. Make straight in the desert a ghighway for xx our God." All the obstacles, all the difficultues that are in the way of the people coming back from Babylon, they are going to be removed. The valleys lifted up, and the mountains and the hills put down, the crooked made straight, and the rough places plain. Just like when we build a road through the difficulty country, that it would take you days to go through, and they build a great big super-hgihway through so you ka can shoot through in a fre few hours. He is going to open up the way and make it easy for work to come back from exile. But we don't have specific reference to exile here. Because we are here not makeing a prediction, but we are dealing with the emotions. We are an anaxumentum introduction here to the whole section, and so what is said relates not merely to this one deliverance through God, but in a whole stream of deliverances that God is going to give His par people on through the grages. It relates to the deliverance from the difficulty of the exile, come through the sin of the max people, and it relatese even more to the thing that has caused the exile, the problem of sin itself, that God is going to upen up the way for the coming of His grace. He is going to make the rough places straight, and open up the way in order that there may come the true answer to the sin question, and therefore it is altogether appropriate to apply it to the coming of John the Baptist, opening up the way, declaring the preparation of the way for the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ. This is not a specific prediction of John the Baptist. Because of the nature of this particular chapter. This particular chapter is touching on these me emotions dealing with the whole **quux** question of God's deliverance from exile, and going on from the sin that causes the exile. And so He is here not predicting John the Baptist, but He is dealing with the emotion, and prediction that God will open up the way for the fulfillemnt of all the pre portions of His work, and the most important of it is, of course, the coing of Christ....end of P 195
