passages:

Deut.1:1 -- These be the words which Moses spake unto all Israel....

Deut.4:44-45 -- And this is the law which Moses set before the children of Israel: These are the testimonies, and the statutes, and the judgments, which Moses spake unto the children of Israel, after they came forth out of Egypt.

Deut.12:. -- These are the statutes and judgments, which ye shall observe to do in the land, which the LORD God of thy fathers giveth thee to possess it, all the days that ye live upon the earth.

Deut.27:1 -- And Moses with the elders of Israel commanded the people, saying, Keep all the commandments which I command **\$50**0 this day.

Deut.28:58 -- If thou wilt not observe to do all the words of this law that are written in this book, that thou mayest fear this glorious and fearful name, THE LORD THY GOD.

Deut.29:20 -- ....all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him....

Deut. 31:24-26 - And it came to pass, when Moses had made an end of writing the words of this law in a book, until they were finished, That Moses commanded the Levites, which bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD, saying, Take this book of the law, and put it in the side of the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God, that it may be there for a witness against thee.

Thus we see the claim of the Pentateuch that Moses wrote it, and commanded that it be preserved.
