4. Isaiah 8:23, 9:1; Matthew 4:15-16, Luke 1:79; Zebulun. Definite reference to Messiah.
24. Isaiah 27:9; Isaiah 59:20, 21. Romans 11:26, 27. very strikingly, peculiar conflation.
3. Isaiah 40:3-5; Matthew 3:3, Mark 1:3, Luke 3:4-6, John 1:23. Voice in the wilderness (some poetic words)
7. Isaiah 42:1-4; Matthew 12:18-21 "Behold my servant" some poetic language.
5. Isaiah 53:4; Matthew 8:17.
21. Isaiah 53:7-8; Acts 8:32, 33.
15. Isaiah 53:12; Luke 22:37. Christ quotes Old Testament and says that it is yet to be accomplished.
24. Isaiah 59:20, 21; Isaiah 27:9; Romans 11:26, 27; very strikingly, peculiar conflation.
14. Isaiah 61:1-2; Luke 4:19. "Spirit of Lord upon me". V. 21 says this day fulfilled
11. Jeremiah 32:6-9, Zech. 11:13; Matthew 27:9, 10. 30 pieces of silver--potter. A picturesque prophecy like Ezekiel. Type? Symbolic prophecy?
9. Daniel 9:26 and 12:11; Matthew 24:15. Old Testament prediction declared still future and interpreted as to being literally fulfilled. "Abomination of desolation."
17. Joel 3:1-5 (2:28-32) Acts 2:17-21 Context?
2. Micah 5:1 (2); Matthew 2:6, Bethlehem.
8. Zechariah 9:9; Matthew 21:5, John 12:14,15. Triumphant entry. John 12:16 claims O. T. prediction.
11. Zechariah 11:13, Jeremiah 32:6-9; Matthew 27:9, 10. 30 pieces of silver--potter. A picturesque prophecy like Ezekiel. Type? Symbolic prophecy?
16. Zechariah 12:12; John 19:37. Is it partly still future?
10. Zech. 13:7; Matthew 26:31. Very common figure. Zech. 13 passage difficult seems to blend.
6. Malachi 3:1; Matthew 11:10, Mark 1:2, Luke 1:76, 7:27; Messenger, poetic
15. Malachi 4:4-5; Luke 1:17. Coming back of Elijah. Except for name Elija
