

Dr. MacRae:--No, indeed, This miracle, like all the teaching of Scripture, is entirely reasonable. But this does not mean that man can learn eternal things by his reason alone. There are many factors that he does not know. God reveals in the Bible vital truths that would otherwise be completely inaccessible to us. At Faith Seminary we do not seek to inculcate a faith that is blind credulity. Our faith is placed in God, the infinite Creator. We seek to learn the precise meaning of the Bible, because it is His revelation to us of the facts that He wants us to know. It is for this reason that we stress the study of Greek and Hebrew, the original languages of Scripture. All of these Scriptures center around one thing, God's provision for man's salvation.

Jesus Christ, the God-man, was the one prefigured by the passover lamb. He was sacrificed for the sin of the whole world. As He hung on Calvary's cross He bore the sins of all who would believe on His name. What a wonderful miracle is the miracle of the God-man. It is a miracle with a purpose, the purpose that you and I might be saved. Oh, how I praise God that He has enabled me to see my need of salvation, to turn from my sin and accept Jesus Christ as Saviour. Oh, that He would enable everyone who is listening to this broadcast to see their need of salvation, to turn away from sin, and to look to Him as Saviour and Lord. Jesus said, (John 3:14-15): "As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up: that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life." Oh, my friend, look to Jesus today, receive Him into your life, be saved through His wonderful sacrifice on Calvary's cross.
