

of Israel, to know wisdom and moosar, to perceive the words of understanding to receive the moosar of wisdom, justice, judgment, and equity. Solomon wrote his book of Proverbs that we might know wisdom and moosar. That we might receive the moosar of wisdom, justice, judgment and equity. It is translated instruction, here, in our English Bibles. Not Chastening or chastisement, here, but instruction. How do you get instruction and chastening and ~~inst~~ chastisement together here in one word, in one idea. It is something that we are to know. something ~~we~~ we are to seek for, to know wisdom and moosar. Down in verse 7, the fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and moosar. It is more than instruction. Wisdom and instruction sound like repetition. Wisdom and instruction, well it is more than that. ^{It's} ~~Moosar~~ Moosar, it is chastening, it is chastisement but it is a chastisement that is good. It is a chastening that accomplished something for us. Verse 8, my son hear the~~s~~ instruction of thy father. ~~xxxxxxx~~ He doesn't say, my son come here, I want to give you a whipping. My son I am exhorting you to come and get the chastening I want to give you. It is not just that you are going to give him a whipping, not just that you are going to give them something that is a punishment, because it is exhortation. You don't exhort children to be whipped by their parents. You exhort the parents, perhaps, to give the child the chastening that is good for him, but here is something addressed to the child, my son, hear the moosar of thy father. And forsake not the law of thy mother. You see it is more than chastening and chastisement in the ordinary sense of the word. Or instruction, either, there is something more, much more to it than that.

Let's look at Proverbs ~~3~~ 3:11. My son, despise not the chastening of the Lord, despise not the moosar of the Lord, neither be weary of his correction for whom the Lord loves He corrects, even as a father the son whom he delights. Now this could be the Lord gives it and we can't help ourselves, but we shouldn't despise it. But in Proverbs 1 there is more than that. We are asked to come and get it. It is something ~~inst~~ that we have an
