And if you are not one of the top~~s~~ beaurocrats, you are not allowed to buy ~~anything~~ anything besides the meager amount you can get in the state stores. And you are kept at a standard of living lower than that of practially anybody in the United States. Russia has great extremes by far than the United States, or of almost any other country in the world, between its top~~s~~ and its bottom. It is a ~~xxxxxx~~ ^{country} that is filled with clas~~s~~s. Though they change more rapidly perhaps, than in a good many other countries.

But free enterprise, a system which is in line with the ~~teaching~~ teaching of the Bible.
