There is no real similarity between the Biblical and the Babylonaan If you want to question that, look up some first hand sources which say story. there is a similarity, and see what they say the similarities are, and if you look in the six of them, as I have, you will find six different alleged similarities, no one of them think the one the others give are worth even mentioning, because when you examine them, you find as first hand scholars of Mesopotamian anitouities agree, that actually they are so different, there is no reltion to the Biblical creation story and the Babylonian story. The Biblical is the great story of how God created the universe, the Babylonian is the story of two groups of gods, fighting each steir other, and it is an altogether different story.
