There is no earthly powere that can resist the potwer of The thing that cramps the will of God is the failure of His more to avail themselaves of His ...4... There is nothing that may not be over done. There is nothing which may not be accomplished if God's people will devote themselves to His pupperexxxand purposes, and follow him as He desires them to do. does not want us ever to stop before a door, and say we can't enter that door. We can't do it. It may be there is another door He wants us to enter now. There may be another theng it is the purpose one of us should fulfill. It may not be His will that one particular one of us should enter one particular door. But there is no door, there is no gate, there is no force which can resist the prayers of God's people, and the determined effort of God's people to carry out His will. Oh, how little is our fiath, how far short we come of taking this casse and breaking it (?5) that the gates of Hell shall not prevail against God's people if they are truly devoted to Him. No, Oh, how far short we fall, and how little we accomplish compared to what He wants us to accomplish, but how sald it is that everyone of us sometime will find ourse tves in a situation where we merit the rebuke of v.23. Everyone of us. Now you may only remain in it a minute or two. You may only remain in it five minutes. You may only remain in it a day or two. But man after man who has followed God, and been used of God has turned aside from God, and the Lord has said, Get thee behind me Sta Satan, thou savorest not the things that be of God, but those that be for man. seen so many men, great leaders of God, who have gallen by the wayside. M. Gray once heard that a man was going to become a professor at McCormick Seminary, and this man was a pastor out in Oregon. James M. Gray, the presidend of the Moody Bibld Institute expressed his joy that this man was coming, because he skid, that fellow and I used to go out on street meetings together as boys. He sind, we believed the word of Christ, and we lead souls into the kingdom.
