The normal process when one is won to Christ, for an interest to be taken in him, and for him to ...1 $\frac{1}{2}$... the word of God, and put in contact with other true Christians, and when you find someone going out and holding a great meeting, and leading thousands of people to come over and make a testimony, you must say praise the Lord for it, and for every one of these that ~~he~~ goes into a sound church where he receives the message of Christ, and is built up, you must say, praise the Lord. It is a wonderful thing that has been done. But if you find a meeting of that type, leading a large number of people to become all enthused and excited, and thinking they had received, and then put into churches where they receive messages that are just ethical discussions or sociological discourses, and give them no food, but a stone, or messages even which tear down the Word of Christ, and defy God's truth, and those people will soon decide this was all a lot of emotional excitement and amounted to absolutely nothing, and drift out again, probably, and2 $\frac{1}{2}$, it is just a subject which a person has to face as to his own attitude toward such a particular meeting, what is the balance between the great good that is done here, and the harm that is being done here. A person has to face it, and I personally think it would be far better to win 100 people to the Lord to go into a sound church to be taught to know the Lord Jesus Christ, and to ~~grow~~ grow in grace, than to get a thousand people to come to the Lord and go into modernist churches where they hear the Word of God denied, and if it isn't denied they are receiving a stone ~~instead~~ instead of bread, and a few of them doubtless wonderfully saved and greatly blessed and stand true in spite of what is around them, but the great mass of them terrifically need3 $\frac{1}{2}$ It is a vital part of the work of the
