But if a Swede comes over to this country, he then has to abide by our laws and drive right. And if he would insist, I like the ~~the~~ Swedish way. I like to drive left, and drive left on Broadway here, Broad Street here, we would soon have difficulty, and collision, and possibly death, and his own feelings and desires in the matter would be accepted by no one as an excuse for his having driven on the left side. The traffic laws of this type are laws which are made in order to make it possible that we shall get along together, and each of us enjoy our lives without interfering with others.
