

origin of the physical world itself is unknown. Third, the origin of main organic types is unknown. There is no evidence in favor of ascending evolution of organic forms. Very little is known as to the causes of evolution. Evolution does not explain the purposes, the nature of the working of this universe. And it is very humorously sometimes it is put, "Why there should be boys and girls and not always all boys and always all girls?" And that's a very genuine question too. It does not explain the purpose in evolution - how and when - this is very important. I have emphasized this again and again in my classes in Apologetics - when and where and how the rational and the moral consciousness come into a human being? Is it the result of evolution or is it the result of creation? Moral and rational consciousness are two things which could never be the result of evolution from material things. These are something which have been endowed to us by God the Creator and that has been beautifully described in the Creation of Man. Evolution cannot explain that. Evolution also cannot explain the universal consciousness that man has about a Deity. From one corner to the other of this great world, people have some kind of consciousness of a deity - though this consciousness may be perverted. In my country people may be worshipping (14.) or four-footed animals or beasts. Somewhere else people may be worshipping something else. But this consciousness of worshipping a deity is there
