If he knows everything, why should he go to seminary at all. He goes to learn. But he turns out to be injured by it. So he sits in class and hears the professor make a statement he never heard before and it shocks him. Actually it may ^{exactly} be a statement I would make in class here. It may be a statement which represents the result of godly, careful study of the Word of God, but it shocks him, and he shuts his mind and says that mustn't come in and, while he closing it out, a dozen other subtle suggestions come into his mind that are contrary to the Word of God and false and that unite together to cut the underpinnings of his faith and of his stand for the Lord.
