Let us pray:

God our Father, we thank you for the wonderful peace of Your wonderful Word. We thank you our Father, that the battle is not to the strong, or the race to the swift, but that our God determines the events, and that all whe come out as you have the terms. O we thank you, our Father, that you permit/in these days to witness to the truth, to lead others to know Jesus as Saviour, and Lord. Help us, we pray, to be active, to be watchful, to be vigilant, to be ready, when our Lord shall come. Oh Help us, our Father, make all these motives to be more effective in our lives, that our lives may be more truly devoted to the service of Him who died, that we might live.
