1. How changeable are all the affairs of life. We imagine things will continue indefinitely, and then suddenly they are completely changed. Even greater changes will come suddenly when our Lord returns to reign.
2. "Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away." The remarkable dependability of God's Word. Its predictions exactly fulfilled; its promises absolutely sure; its warnings entirely true.
3. The Jew as God's signpost, testifying to the truth of God's Word and to the certainty that Christ will return. Only if the Jews entirely disappear can we conclude that Christ is not coming back after all.
4. How easily our love for an absent one grows cold, with the passage of time! How easily the church lost its first love, after it ceased to look with longing for Christ's return.
5. Discuss what one should do in order to be sure of being ready when Christ comes.
6. The misery of life in a world in which Satan is prince, contrasted with the glory that will follow Christ's return.
