Christians have found-that-from - known that from the beginning. That is nothing knew. The Jews believed it , that the entire Old Testament was inspired and free from error. He is not giving them a new idea. He is stressing the Adea that it is is all profitable, that it is all useful, that it is all needs to be studied, and he is giving the reason for that it, it is profitable because it is all inspired of God, and x of course if you take it allin context, the verses before tells Timothy how fortunate it he is that verse 15 says, that from a child thou has t known the wh-Holy Scriptures which are able to make thee xk wise unto salvation through fait -faith which is in Christ Jesus, for divery scripture, being inspired of God is also profitable, a in other words, Timothy, you have known these scriptuares, and these scriptuescres, which Timothy has known, are able to make thee-wise unto salvation, an-s-and since these scriptures are inspired, every portion of is of benefit. them is of value, is important for the one who is to be truly the man of God. So when it says scripture here k in the AmericanStandard Version here , it is not saying that those part-osparts of scripture that are inspired-,-an inspired are profitable, and those that are not are not profitable. It is saying every part of the scripture, .. is profitable and that scripture which is-he collection is talking about is that/selection of books thatwhich Timothy was p brought up to understand is the word of God, in other words talking about the Old Testan-ne Testament, x here, and of course the New T stament gives us abundant that eveldence evidence that what he here says about the Old k testame nt Paul
