quite confusing. And often a chapter really does <sup>not end</sup> ./. until several verses after  
what is called the end or start several verses before. I mean the unit of  
thought. But this ~~chapter. Th-~~ chapter here, this psalm is rather unique  
and it has a very queer verse division. Look at verse four there. You have  
the ... <sup>stanza</sup> that starts with heavens declare the glory of God and ends with ~~and~~  
words ~~and~~ and their lines have gone out through all ~~the ends of~~ the earth,  
and the words ~~through-~~ to the ends of the earth. Then you start a new stanza,  
in them <sup>hath</sup> ~~he said,~~ set a tabernacle for the sun, and then you go on with the next  
verse, That is one of the queerest verse division anywhere in the Bible. It  
takes the last half line of one stanza, and the first half line of the next stanza  
to make them one verse. I think that the Holy Spirit purposefully allows  
this to be done, in order to be a warning to ~~them-~~ us that we must take the  
Bible as a unit, and study it and not allow the human divisions to necessarily  
confuse them. Now, let us look at the verse one again. The heavens declare  
the glory of God; ~~and the firmament~~.... We see a statement there which  
superficially would mean a great deal more to the people of hundreds of years  
ago than it does today, although reasonably it should mean far more to people  
today than to people hundred years ago. The differences.. There are two  
differences. But the first ~~dei-~~ difference is the artificial light. One hundred  
years ago, ~~//H//~~ everybody in the evening, wherever they went, they ~~star-~~ thought  
the sky was just covered by the brilliant stars, <sup>unless</sup> ~~and that was~~ <sup>it was</sup> of course ~~not~~ the  
cloudy night, and it made tremendous impression upon the minds of the people
