Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I have commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat? And immediately the man jumps to another point. That is all that we do. And I find even with good Christians when you discuss a matter, you raise a point, and then they & just move to another point before this one is answered. It is human nature, VI guess. He says, the woman, he sas, thou gavest to live with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat. Adam was not to be blamed at all, was he? She gave it to him, and it was the New Testament, you find that Adam - through Adam came sin into the world. As by one man sin came, so by one man salvation comes. Adam did not escape any blame by casting it on somebody else. And we cannot escape blames by casting on somebody else. We do not have to listen to the other person. It is our faults strictly, if we do what is wrong. And so, God does not even bother answering this question. He simply turns to her and asks her questions and she caststhe blame on to the serpent, and then God goes on to give them the message and in the course of this message, God shows them It will that it has a heavy about them pretty well.
