Now I want to make look at a few of these passages with you, and jametate just to see what you threathink about these passages. Do you think that these passages fit with an idea that these Old Testament writers are describing the church Church today? Or do you think they are describing a period which might come before the me return f of Christ? Or does it seem more reasonable to think they are describing something that comes after Christ comes back to this earth?

Now the first of these to which I wish to call your attention is the Book of Micah. In the Book of Micah we have three main sections to this wonderful prophetic book, the Book of Micah. And in each of these three sections we have a procedure which is quite common in the prophetic books of the Old Testament. The prophets of the Old Testament did not simply sit down and write out instructions for us today. They were men who wrote and spoke to their own generations. They talked to the people of Israel there; they gave those people God's Word for then them. And doubtless there was much that they gave that was never written down and kept in the Bible, because God gave it to them simply for that time, and it served its purpose when that time was over.

RRX But those things that God gave the prophets that He wished to be of value to His people through all future days, those He caused that they should write down, and
