and the Picts who could plunder them come in from the north and plunder them.

Having become accustomed to rely on the Roman soldiers, and not trained to fight to defent themselves, they requested the Anglo-Saxons and two

Angles, Saxons and Jutes to come over from the continent and protect them. They came over and fought back the Scots and Picts but when they had done so they did not simply go back home again. Instead they turned on the Britons and set to work to conquer them. Then the Britons had to fight for their lives. A great multitude of them were killed, and others were forced back into the manut mountains of Wales. But during this period of 150 years or so our knowledge of events is almost nil. During that period of 150 years or so (2nd) in Britain and on the continent most people were too busy just trying to survive to have time to write much or to think much. It was a time when a human life was rated very cheap. There was little opportunity for education, or little time for it. It was just mainly a question of managing to keep alive.
