I see Dr. Geueros down here and how I was impressed when I first heard the story of his father and his uncle living out there in inland Brazil, a group of people there living a poor life, no future, no accomplishment, no interest in betterment. And a missionary came and preached the Gospel and out of that group of people two young men-- Dr. Gueros's father and Dr. Geuros' uncle-- received the Lord Jesus into their hearts. They went and received an education and became ministers of the Gospel, and they did a great work in Brazil. The children and the grandchildren of those two men, have occupied high places in Brazil not only in the leadership of at least two denominations but also in the political life, in the social life. One of them was governor of a provence. They are lawyers, they are doctors. They are people of distinction in Brazil. Dr. Gueros told me how one time he went back to that area from which his father had come. There he found people--doubtless relatives of his-- who had not received the Gospel and they were still in the same degraded condition they were before the Gospel came.

The way to improve the world is to bring light. The way to improve the world is to bring people to the knowledge of Christ. When Christ is in their hearts they go ahead and they improve things around them inevitably.

In those years in college, I remember how subtle was the activity of some of those professors. How they would take a man and play with him, lead him on. Let him think he knows all about evolution and he can convince the professor he is wrong, and get him in a corner and make a fool of him and the rest of the class
