The tendency today is to put everything on computers, to do everything with machinery, as far as possible; there's a tendency to become impersonal, and we must not go to that extent. We must keep up the personal touch, ~~particularly~~ particularly if we are leaders/ of God's people. That is very important, that we keep that ~~up~~ up. An yet we can save a great deal of time by definite arrangements, lpractical arrangements, and by the use of means that will save us time. I think we might very appropriately be mentioned here the importance of a filing system. It is so easy for you to accumulate notes, accumulate clippings, other material, and ~~put~~ put them on ~~in~~ a pile, and say, "Some day I'm going to arrange these so that I can know exactly where everything is." It's very easy to keep saying, "Some day." but the time comes when you need something in a hurry, and you are called upon for a special task, a special opportunity, and you have all the material that you need for it, but if you don't have it arranged in such a way that you can speedily find the precise things that you want, it is not of much value to you. It is very important in this connection to avoid
