and command. The winds were contrary, but they were doing what Jesus had commanded, and so they struggled hard to overcome the difficulties and to push on. Circumstances may be a real factor of importance and of help to us in very determining the Lord's will, but they are a/**Reatily** minor factor, at least as far as any direct guidance of the Lord is concerned, because often they can be interpreted in either way, and the important thing/ is, what is the Lord's will, not what are the circumstances.

3. Dreams and Visions.

In the Biblical account God often led people by dreams, and by visions. It seems often. so. (?) And yet, when you take it and xeekate in relation to the whole Scripture, it's not so often. Take through the centuries, through the ages, and therease there are many cases where God has done this. By comparison, the totality of human life, or of the life of God's followers, they are comparatively few. And the devil can give
