Sometimes I look back with nostalgia to those early pioneering days. I worked very hard in those days. At the end of the first year of the seminary I was also absolutely exhausted. It was a tough struggle. There were disappointmets. There were problems. There were difficulties. It was real promeering work, but God gave us strength and gave us wisdom, and above all taught us wonderful lessons of trusting Him and looking to Him for Oh, leadership in all that we did. O, may God enable us to continue the same spirit and the same outlook that we had when the seminary began. We may not have to p face the privations and the disappointments, the problems of pioneering, but may God enable us to use all the facilities He has given us for His glory, to put Him first on every point, to look to no human being, but to the LJC° as our leader, and to follow Him and His work until He comes.
