lives that they would catch the infection and so they would not go near the others. There was one sailor who was very ill, and he called another sailor who was well and he said to him, I'm hungry, I need water, I'm so sick, he said. Here's a little property I have, I will give it to you if you will only bring me something. And the other man brought him a little something, and then the other man began to recover and the sailor then spoke to somebody else and cursed and said that fellow there deceived me and said he was going to die and I could have his property, and here he is getting better, and he was so disgusted he would not come near him again and the man died. But some of the sailors were impressed with the way that the pilgrims even with f all their sufferings, they tried to help the sailors to help those who were sick and to give some assistance to them even though half of them also died. But they got established. The wonderful thing is that in the next 10 years only 3 or 4 died out of the whole group, when half of them died in those fhree months that spring. They got established there. Immediately they said, We'e got to pay this money back to those people in England. Now how are we going to produce the utmost possible, in order to take care of ourselves, in order to have something to pay them for the cost of our coming over. Well they said, We've go t to have complete control, we've got to have a controled economy. Everybody has got to do their best. Let everybody give what he can. From each one according to his ability, and then we will give everybody according to their need. So they took the land there, and said to each family, This is your land for thisyr. You work on this land. You g bring in everything you can produce into the common treasury. Then we will give you from it what you need. The people worked on their land and had enough to get through the next winter, but when summer came the food was practically gone, and they had to live on berries and eels, and whatever they could for a good bart of the summer it was very tough going. The next harvest was the same way. They got enought to get through the winter but hardly enough to get thro the summer. The gov. said We must do something about this. It just is not working. Now he said, this communistic sort of a system that we are using here, From each according to his ability, to each according to his need, it just is not working. Maybe we'd better try something else. And so he the counsel to agree with him and they said, Now in our thild year we are going to use a different system altogether.
