it, to study the Word with this in mind, to think of it, and to move forward as He desires us to do. Let us pray:

O God our Father, we understand what your will is, but O our God how far short we fall of doing it. How easily we are turned aside to the things of this world that attract us, to the types of interest, to the types of learning, types of activity of this world, good in themselves in having a proper place in our lives, but how easy for them to get a place beyond what they should. Help us our Father to accomplish the purposes for which you have us here. Help us to make our lives count in the reaching of souls for Christ. Help us to make our lives count in helping others, perhaps the ones with whom we rum shoulders with here in the seminary, the ones we meet in our churches we so we can help them grow in grace and in the knowledge of the Lord. But 0 our Lord help us each one to know that it is your will our sanctification—this long process, and endless process while we are in the body. But help us, our Father, to make progress in it. We ask in Jesus Name. Amen.
