small part of His dealings with His people then. Now we have the Word of God and it is rare if ever that we can expect to hear a supernatural voice.

You probably heard the story of the man who once that he heard a voice calling, PC, PC, PC. He decided that it meant he was to be a minister. So he went before the Presbytery and asked to be ordained. They asked for his qualifications and he had none, but he said the Lord had definitely called him. The Lord had said PC, PC - Preach Christ, Preach Christ. Well after examining him thoroughly they said they though PC meant Plow Corn. It is very easy to misinterpret a voice. To misunderstand it. God has given us His Word. He does not ordinarily lead us that way these days.

Second. Not by looking for dreams. God led people in Biblical times often through dreams. God sometimes perhaps leads people with dreams today, but it is very very easy to misunderstand dreams, to misinterpret them, and it is a fact that most of them have no interpretation. Everyone dreams. Anyone who says he does not simply does not would remember because a person could not live without having a number of dreams every night. These dreams are mostly a combination of thoughts that we have had or are the result of what we have eaten, or of our general situation, our general circumstances. They do not in most cases have a meaning for us. God might choose to teach us by a dream but it is very unusual and we should be cautious about this way of finding God's will.

Third. Not by our Feelings. I have heard of people who have == who would say, Well I have liberty to do this; I have no liberty to go there; I have no liberty to do that. Paul was forbidden of God to go into certain areas. He did not have liberty to do this and that, but
