

- 1 Text: Heb. 11:32-35a
Jeremiah exemplifies one who suffered repeated disappointments
Ps. 1:3
- 2 Not he, but what he does will prosper
God's plan is best whatever it is
- 3 No excuse for laziness
Jeremiah's call and unpleasant assignment
- 4 He urged the people left to stay in the land ch. 42
Attitude of those who refused his message 43:2-7
- 5 Prophets were not puppets with no feelings in them
15:15-18; 20:14-18
20:7 You have deceived me
- 7 Jeremiah's feelings not wicked or would be so indicated
Had a loving heart
Assured that God would protect him 1:18
- 8 God does not always protect his people this way 26:20ff
God's purpose in our development
- 9 Some have been greatly used of God then have fallen and become castaways
- 10 Experience when first reading the prophets--just words
Need to get the principles
