have been elected from before the foundation of the world. This is very clearly taught in Scripture. It is also taught that God does not desire that anyshould perish but that all should come to a knowledge of the Lord, and that whosever times to be contradictions. A simply illustration will show that this is not an absurd statement.

The fourth point I wish to stress today is one of tremendous importance to the lives of all of us. You have a part in God's plan. Paul says, How can they hear without a preacher? Jesus leaves us in the world after we are saved so we can win others to Him. The means God has chosen to use to build up the body of ChirstChirst is by means of individual Christians speaking to others individual Christians about Him. It is a part of His plan to win souls to Him and you are a vital part of His plan. When Christians are saved they need a lot of instruction. Everyone of us has periods of weakness and doubt when we need help of other Christians. Part of God's plan for all Christians is that they help others grow in grace. These two very comprehensive headings of evengelism and pastoral work apply to all Christians, but particularly to those whom He calls apart to full
