Learn to live with it, learn to be satisfied with it, learn to see the great values that might be injured if you gave vent to your feelings, and above all as the Lord here has a purpose in it, "bring the blind by a way that they knew not and I will lead them by paths they have not known." God has caused --- called us to bring the blind by ways they don't know. God calls many men to take a few truths of Scripture and make them known. I've heard wonderful sermons on true Christian teaching drawn from verses that had nothing to do with it. And I've said, Praise God for the true Christian teaching that has been given, even though the man hangs it on a peg where it did not belong at all.

But I hope that our graduates will not interpret the Bible that way. I hope they will give the great truths and put the stress where the Bible puts its stress on these truths, but I hope that they will be studying the entire Bible, learning sound methods of interpretation and learning to understand how God has fit it all together so ~~xxxx~~ that every part of it is a part of His guidance for His people as they go through this brief time that He gives them life upon this earth. Let's pray.

Our Father, we thank you for your Word. For the depths of your word. For the many subjects it covers, We thank you above all for Jesus our Saviour, for without Him we would have no hope but through Him we can be saved. But O our God ~~wax~~ He wants us to be satisfied not simply with these great truths that He gives of salvation.
