There is no speech nor language where their voice is not heard. Their line is gone out througghout the earth and their word to the end of the world."

Once I was talking to a young man who was a student at a small theological seminary. He had a professor in Apologetics there-- I forget the man's name, we'll call him Jones just for a name-- and he was telling me how Dr. Jones had shown so conclusively that all our arguments for the existence of God, the argument from science, the arguments from the greatness of the world, the arguments from the need of a creator,-- they don't ~~prove~~ prove anything! You just have to assume God! You just have to presuppose God. Well, I told him I'd rather go with Paul and with David than with Dr. Jones!
