"The field is wasted, the land mourneth; for the corn is wasted, the new wine is dried up, the oil languisheth." He goes on describing this situation in which they are, and God has found it necessary in dealing with a race of human beings who are so prone to put them Him out of their minds and to forget Him. He has found it necessary great, natural calamities to come, to permit sin situations to come into our lives in which there is no way that we can handle it, because He knows that man is so slow, once things go a little min nicely with him, to forget God, to turn away from God. And it is necessary that the Lord shall keep us aware of the fact that He controls all things and that everything that we have is from Himself. I don't know whether this was the reason He let me have this experience three years ago, but it certainly had that effect. of I was driving in the car on the turn-pike -- I just don't know what hape- happened, but I found the car going over th and the next time I came to with the car on its side and some big boots beside me , and the a man who was standing there in the car on the side, and he was saying put Put up a flare so no other car will run it into it , and then he said I will have to kim kick out this windshield so I can get this man out, and with that I became unconscious again. They carried me twenty miles to the hospital and there they in the hospital they examined me and found that I had seven bones bron- broken but not noe none of them proved to be serious brakes . And the Lord gave me the most remarkable recovery from it. That night at the hospital the man said soon after I had gotten in there he said We will take you in the next room here , we have to take a couple of stitches in your arm. And I said Why is that, and he said Well, your arm has been cut with a blunt instrument . Well, they's took me in the next room , they closed the arm here and sewed it up with stitches and then the Ex-ray, and the next day they put my leg in a cast. I only learned six weeks later that I had two vertebrae broken but not a bad break and within a year I was able again to take 40 pounds
