I believe there was enough c iticism of that immediately so that in recent copies of the RSV you do not find it. But it just illustrates the fact that those who are moved of Satan to destroy grax Christian faith are not rational when they deal with matters of Christ. They may be great intelligent men in other ways. But they are not rational in such matters.

Now that doesn't mean we should take a problem of NT quotation and simply brush it aside and say this is a statement of some unbeliever. We should look, as I looked at the original Hebrew in these particular cases Imentioned to you and see what the evidence is. It is amazing how frequently if you look at the evidence closely the difficulties will disappear.
