

of their love for God as they proceed to obtain objectives and purposes of their own without completely sanctifying those purposes, without bringing them into obedience to the love of God.

Our love to God should be constant, not simply something that shows itself in great crises. I remember when Daniel -- I remember hearing about when Daniel Webster in one of his great orations, in his reply to Haine which was considered one of the great orations in American history. Haine had given a great talk in the U.S. Senate relating to a certain ~~xxxx~~ vital issue. Daniel Webster rose and answered Haines. When I was a boy we had a poem of someone giving Webster's reply to Haines. It was one great oration of American History.

After he gave his tremendous moving talk which has been repeated over and over. After he gave it someone said to him, Mr. Webster, How long did it take you to prepare that wonderful oration that you gave. Webster said, All my life has a been a preparation for that.

So if we truly love God we are in the little things, in the activities of our lives day by day we are preparing for the great ~~xxx~~ crises that may come to us and we never know when they may come. How easy it is in your contacts--everyone of us has many many contacts with people. It is easy to just

and keep away from this person, and to be with people who irritate you and to just keep quiet. To hear people speak dogmatically in criticism of Christianity and keep quiet and say nothing.

I don't say you have to argue with people all the time. I don't say that everything you speak you have to witness for the Lord. But if you truly love the Lord you will find opportunity after opportunity to present the glorious Christ many of whom have never heard the Gospel clearly ~~tozpeopze~~ and properly presented. If you make a few people dislike you, and if you spoke to 1000 people who may turned their backs on you and looked the other way, and one that seemed to you the most unlikely of all. They gave no indication at the time that your words had any effect upon him whatever. But God caused the witness you gave to sink into that person's heart and that person turned to Christ. The angels of God rejoice over one sinner that is saved, more than 100 righteous people that need no repentance.

Everyone of us has lots of opportunities to speak for Christ, which God could use. Everyone of us ~~ix~~ in our daily contacts needs to think through this question: "Do you love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your mind, with all your soul, with all your strength."

I don't say a human being is divided into four parts which can be called the ~~body~~, the soul, the mind, the strength, the heart. I don't think we need to argue whether we're made up of three parts, or whether we're made up of two parts. It is more important
