In our actions in our thoughts in all that we do. He calls us to show love to all who are truly His.

Are you prepared to meet your God? Are you prepared to meet the Lord Jesus when he comes? Are you prepared to meet him if he should come very soon? Will you find you as he desired to find Paul and all the disciples if he should come then? Will he find you giving the food in its season to His people. Helping others to grow in grace and in the knowledge of the Lord. Will he find you as one whose whole life is lived as though he desires his work be carried forward, and that his purpose should be accomplished. And that you and I should be purified, should be made such as will win his approval if he should come very very soon.

Prepare to meet thy God. Are you prepared? Let us think about that. Let us work on that. Let us make our lives truly such as he would have them. Let us pray.

Our God we thank you for the fact you haverevealed much to us about the future. We thank you for all that you have revealed to us that Jesus Christ is truly God, that he contools all things and that he is interested in every single one of us. We can meet him in prayer. We can know he is with us. We can have close fellowship with him. We can be crucified with Christ and live but he lives in us. It's easy for us for a minute, for an hour, for a day to forget him. O our God help us to be prepared to meet him. To be ready when he comes. Whether we disagree about certain points of doctrine or not, whether we disagree about certain details, we are told clearly over and over that in such an hour as we expect not the Lord will come. May he find each of us ready. We ask in Jesus' Name. Amen.
