

- 1 Seminary charged no tuition in past.
 Student in 1943 in opening chapel where AAM remarked that we had no
 draft doggers in the seminary because of the amount of work we require
 so the student volunteered to join the army.
 John 17:13-20
- 2 Jesus prayed God would sanctify his disciples through the truth
 Student to whom Howard Hendricks had devoted so much time in trying
 to help him had run off with another woman and left debts behind
 proving himself an utter reprobate. Not sanctified
- 3 God leaves us here to sanctify us
 Many have distorted ideas of what sanctification is
 Is not going off by oneself in the wilderness
 Is not saying pious phrases
 Kipling's phrase about meeting triumph and disaster the same
- 4 2 Cor. 3:15 increasing glory. Progress in sanctification
 Beholding as in a glass = reflecting in a mirror
 Reflect what we see Mirror
 Reflect on (meditate) what we see. Contemplate
- 5 Student who after one chapel service suggested an "improvement" in the
 seminary's curriculum by dropping many courses and substituting
 for them Systematic Theology instead
 What is systematic theology?
 Requires for its first interpreting verses correctly
 Experience in seminary when the professor uses verses superficially to
 prove a point not taught by the verses! Was told it "summarized"
 the thought of the passage.
- 6 God's instrument for our sanctification is His Word
- 7 Picked up the book in a bookstore entitled "How to Become a Bishop
 without being Religious"
 Worthwhile to spend several years learning to interpret the Word
 even if never get into a position where you are expounding it for others.
