

- 1 Isaiah 53:5 "chastisement of our peace" (KJV); "punishment that brought us peace" (NIV)  
Meaning of "peace" (shalom) Ex. 4:18 well-being
- 2 Means more than the cessation of war  
Various translations given shalom in KJV  
The musar of Christ means more than his sufferings
- 3 Means one's activity performed to accomplish a purpose  
Hard work, effort  
Francis Schaeffer's practicing his Sunday sermon regularly
- 4 Martin Luther's musar  
John Calvin's musar  
His experiences with Farrel
- 5 Calvin's knowledge came through hard work  
To be good for something
- 6 Musar not only means activity but intelligent activity  
Student who had no problem with Greek grammar but who could not remember  
the vocabulary  
Miss Converse, the Latin teacher  
Mr. Good worked near the stove (TOV)  
Presbyterian Minister's Fund for intelligent planning
