He took a hold of it and with that extra little help it was a simple thing to get on the trail. From there I made it easily to the top and came back down. I never saw another person all day long! That was the only person I saw, and he came along just at the right instant.

God works all things together for good in accordance with His purposes. God is interested in even the little things of our lives. He is here. Do we realize His presence? Is He someone we read of in a book? Is He someone we hear people talk about? Or is He someone who is interested in every little detail of our ~~lives~~ lives? One who is willing and anxious to help us, to accomplish the purposes that He has in mind. Do you have that consciousness of God?

He that ~~saxix~~ cometh to Him ~~haxix~~ must believe that He is. Yes we believe Him. We read about Him. We know how great He is. He is there watching. We know who Mrs. Thatcher is. She is over there in England. We know those things. And if they were right here in this room we would feel a little different than we do when we read about them in the paper. But it is comparatively unimportant to us. We know that God is. Yes He is. But do you realize that God is right here and that everything you do, everything you think, every purpose you have, every attitude you have. He is interested in us.

We see somebody in a situation where just a word from ~~ixix~~ you God might use. God might use it to turn them to the truth. God might use it to turn them ~~axix~~ away from evil things they are doing. God might use it to turn them toward Christ. But you hesitate. You don't say a word. What would they think of you? What would their attitude be? Would they repulse you? Suppose you realized that God is there. And God is interested in this person. God is interested in ~~axix~~ what you do. God is present. You would not care what they are going to think of you. You would be interested in what He thinks of you. ~~ixix~~ And your attitude would be entirely different.

We hesitate about doing things because we don't realize that God is there. You speak out to your wife. Some little thing happens you don't like, and you speak roughly to her. You say something you would not say if you stopped to think about it. But if you realized that God is right there, and that God does not want you to do that you would hold yourself back. You would not say that cruel remark or ~~thaxix~~ take that unpleasant attitude. If you realized that God is there.

You speak before some people. You give a message. You finish and think, Well did I do decently or didn't I? Did they like it or didn't they like it? But if your realized God is there you wouldn't think of that. You would think, Did I give
