But I feel far more disappointed when a bright student with a high IQ simply listens to material, writes it down, writes it on an exam and forgets it. I know one such very bright student who went through the whole course, got A's in just talked about everything, and when I talked with him about a matter after the end course of the semester I found that practically nothing remained in his mind of what he had taken in seminary. It was a tremendous wastage eg-pr of people simply taking the material in, writing it on the exam and forgetting about it. This man I am thinking of could have been one of the most brilliant seminary students we ever had, instead of that I doubt if he remembers a thing that he received in seminary and the books that he now writes now contain statements that had been completely discussed and fully answered, refuted during the courses that he took. He learned the question, learned the refutation, write it down on the exam and simply forget about it.
