Then, a little later I heard a man named Larry Jones of whom I had never heard before. On the program there was with him Stan Mooneyham, of whom I have heard, although I don't recall just what, but this was a very, very interesting program in which they showed pictures of the refugees from Nicaragua and told about the persecution of the people in Nicaragua and many of the refugees fled because their sons would be seized in their middle or late teens and sent off to fight against the contras without any training at all, and most of them died within the next few the days / after they were taken. He showed/Indians who were being terrible treated by the communists there and many of whom fled, but in Hur they were was not enough the people simply put them inside of an enclosure and kept them there as refugees, allowed them to come, and gave them a tiny bit of food, but there was no possibility of earning anything, and he said they have rain ten months of the year.
