against some of the extremes of the Well° school, largely on the part of men who have been working in OT° archaeology. As they have discovered (uncovered) point after point at which the evidence of archaeology in Palestine or in other of the Mesopotamian a lands fits with statements of the Bible and does not fit with the Bible as reconstructed by the HOm°, these men have tended to regard more and more sections of the OT° as representing historic fact. Yet most of them still maintain the essential points of the Well° system, and though they may insist that Well°'s idea of history and of religion was in error, they still declared that the books of the Pent° were not written by Moses or by any individual authors, but represent a composite production made by the interweaving of contradictory documents that came into existence over a long period of time.

In Scan° there is a group of scholars, known as the Uppsala school, which attacks the entire Well° theory, but which itself presents a fiew that is, if possible, were even more inimical to Chn° truth. According to the views of Engnell and the Uppsala school, very little, if any, of the Pent° was written down until after the time of the exile, and it all came into existence from short sections which gradually were developed through oral transmission from the ideas of various individuals.

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
