

been discovered in archeology that would show fraud, misrepresentation, or error in either Testament. We cannot expect to prove the Bible by archeology. The great subjects with which the Bible primarily deals--man's relation to God, and God's provision for man's salvation--are matters that are not susceptible to archeological evidence. Archeology demolishes many of the attacks that unbelievers have made against the Bible, and disproves many of the arguments advanced to show that Christianity is merely the result of a historical development. In addition, archeological material gives help for the precise understanding of many Biblical statements.
