Some interpreters insist that most of the 1 2 symbolic acts described in the books of Isa, Jer and Ezek are merely visions. They say, for instance, that Isaiah could not actually have 5 gone "naked and barefoot" for three years, because this would have been indecent; there-7 fore, he must simply have had a vision in which the did so. They say that Jeremiah could not possibly have taken his girdle all the distance 10 to Euphrates to bury it and then returned all 11 that distance to dig it up. They say that 12 Ezekiel could not actually have lain beside a 13 tile for 390 days because it would have been mit 14 impossible to lie still so long. These and 15 similar arguments are sometimes elaborated at 16 length. However, a little reflection will show 17 that to consider these symbolic acts as merely 18 visions would defeat their purpose, which was 19 not to give the prophet a new understanding, but 20 to seize the attention of the people. To hear 21 Isaiah say that he had walked naked and barefoot 22 for three years in a vision would add little to 23 the effect of his messages. To see the prophet 24 walking around in a state of dress quite unbe-<sup>25</sup> coming his station in life would arouse interest
