specialization. Early in the 20th cent. Friedrich Delitzsch gave his famous "Babylon and
Bible" lectures before the German Kaiser, aiming
to show that everything of value in Biblical
teaching was merely a pale reflection of Babylonian ideas. In 1933 the noted American archaeologist, James Henry Breasted wrote his book,

The Dawn of Conscience, to prove that ethical
understanding really began in ancient Egypt.

Attempts have been made to show that the

Israelite prophets were merely examples of a

type of activity that was common at that period.

Some critics have held that they were a reflection of a phenomenon that occurred among the

Canaanites but not elsewhere. Others have held that they represent an influence that was wide
spread throughout the Near East.

Before looking at the alleged similarities a few points should be noted. The Hebrew prophet was one who claimed to speak for God. He was in most cases quite independent of any direct control by a king or by ecclesiastical officials. He delivered the message that God had given him. Very frequently this was a message of denunciation of the people, the king, or the priests for
