king over Israel, and then rushed out of the house (II Kings 9:1-10). Jehu's associates said to him, "Wherefore came this mad fellow to thee?" The use of the word meshuggah in reference to the prophet has been taken by some as showing that the prophets engaged in orgiastic ecstasy. However, under the circumstances, this would be a very natural way for the onlookers to speak of the messenger who talked privately to Jehu and then rushed out of the house, and does not necessarily throw any light on the real nature of the prophets. It is quite common for God's spokesmen to be considered mad. Even the Apostle Paul was called 'mad' on 18 occasion (Acts 26:24-25). It is thus evident how very few are the 20 references to the prophets that could give the 21 slightest suggestion that they engaged in orgi-22 astic activities or fell into trances. When one 23 of the most generally reliable of the critical 24 writers can make the unfounded statement quoted 25 above about the activities of the prophets in
