origin: concentration of early Hebrews was closer to Aramaic

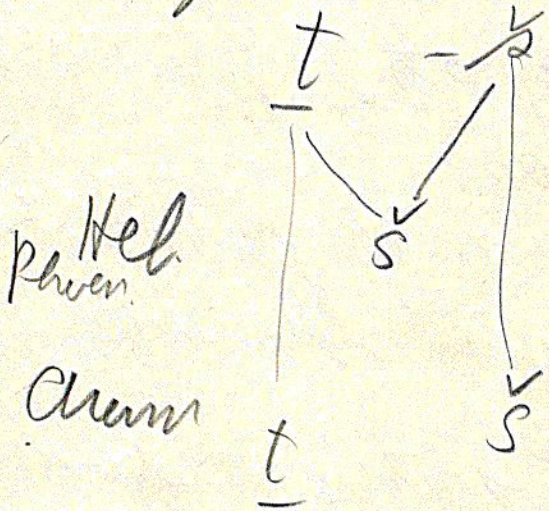
